NY State is an expensive state. We have negotiated a very reasonable room rate for NYS yet there are some other costs. The airport shuttle has not yet resumed since COVID and may not by October. Likewise, there is both paid parking and free on-street parking. The Hilton/city lot is \$15/day if you request a ticket at check-in from the Hilton. They would add \$15/day to your bill for the days you request. We recommend paid parking for Thursday night. At check-in, you will be asked for a credit card for incidentals, even if you reserve your room via the 314th.

The 314th association will have a registration table Thursday evening in the lobby, and we ask that you check-in with us when you check-in at the Hilton. If you are not arriving Thursday evening, we ask that you indicate on the registration form under Special Notes what time you think you'll be arriving. On Friday and Saturday, the front desk can direct you to our hospitality room – to check-in with us.

A hot breakfast in the Hilton's restaurant with tax and tip is \$20. There is also a Dunkin Donuts within walking distance of the Hilton. The wait time there can be long and there are very few tables. If you desire a hot breakfast, we encourage you to join our group in our dedicated room for a hot breakfast.
